New Year Jig

32Bar Jig for 3C

Devised by Maureen Robson

- 1-8 1C dance a right shoulder figure of 8 on the side of the dance.
- 9-16 1st 2nd & 3rd C dance right shoulder reels of 3 on the side.
- 17-24 1W followed by her partner dance behind 2W up between 2nd couple down behind 2M & across the set to second place facing out, her partner finishing also in second place on his own side. 2nd couple moving up on bars 23 & 24.
- 25-32 1st & 3rd C dance RH across once round, 1st with 2nd C dance LH across once round.

Repeat having passing one couple

Note - 1st W faces out ready to start each movement.

32 bar Reel for 3C's in a 4C set

Bars

- 1 – 8 1, 2 & 3C's, taking hands on the sides, set, cross over RH & face clockwise, chase half way round the set finishing on own sides. Order now (3,2,1).
- 9 – 16 Repeat bars 1-8 but this time cross LH & face ANTI- clockwise & chase, to finish back in original places.
- 17 – 24 1C turn RH, cast off 1 place (2C step up on 3 & 4), take nearer hands and dance down between 3C and cast up into 2nd place.
- 25 - 28 1C dance RHs across, 1W with the 2C, 1M with the 3C, all three couples finishing BACK IN THE SIDELINES (hands by their sides), ready for...
- 29 – 32 All 3C's turn RH.

Repeat from second place.

Recommended tune:

The Whales' Moo, from the "Aye Afloat" CD by Keith Smith & Muriel Johnstone

Notes:

After second time through the original first couple stay in 3rd place and move down on bars 3&4 of the second repeat. Fourth couple start by setting and crossing up into third place to begin the dance.

Bars 25-28 - This needs to be finished in the sidelines in straight lines before entering into the RH turn to give these eight bars a tidy look.
